**REGISTRATION AND ACCOMMODATION**

The 10th Annual Meeting of the International Society for the History of the Neurosciences and the 10<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the European Club for the History of Neurology will be held on July 5<sup>th</sup> -9<sup>th</sup> 2005, at New Hall, St Andrews University, Scotland.

Please note that there are seven unusual features of the arrangements for the Meeting having implications for Registration and Accommodation:

1. The Meeting Program begins at 9.30 am Tuesday July 5<sup>th</sup> but we expect that many of those attending will have arrived at New Hall late on the afternoon of July 4<sup>th</sup>. You will therefore need to register for **either** five nights (Monday to Friday, leaving Saturday am) **or** four nights (Tuesday to Friday, leaving Saturday am). Other than for Day Registrants, it will not be possible to register for shorter periods. The meeting concludes Saturday mid-morning.
2. The Meeting is fully residential with a division between Accommodation and Registration charges that is very different from usual.
3. The Accommodation charges are completely inclusive, covering breakfast, morning and afternoon tea/coffee, lunch, and dinner. Special dietary requirements can be met.
4. One type of accommodation is available for single persons but there are two types of accommodation for those attending with an Accompanying Person.
5. Day Registration (without Accommodation) is available and covers morning and afternoon tea/coffee and lunch. It does not include the Thursday RCPE Symposium and RCSE Museum visit.
6. Registration and accommodation bookings can be made **only** through ISHN. No bookings can be made with New Hall.
7. Because ISHN has no mechanism for managing currency fluctuations and St. Andrews charges us a fixed amount in Great Britain Pounds (GBP) for the use of New Hall, we cannot accept payments, whether by cheque, bank transfer, or credit card in any currency other than GBP.

## **Registration** (Revised May 16)

After the 13<sup>th</sup> of May, the Registration Fee includes a surcharge of 20%. The fees listed below include this surcharge; you do not need to perform an additional calculation.

For both Registered and Accompanying Persons, the Registration and Accommodation charge include all the social functions, namely, the St Andrews walks, the Scottish entertainment, the Annual Dinner (including wines), and the demonstration of the use of water in prolonging life.

There is an absolute limit of 50 participants in the Seminar at the Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh (RCPE) and the guided tours of the Museum of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (RCSE) on the morning and afternoon respectively of Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July. It is most unlikely that Accompanying Persons will be able to participate in either of these events.

The Registration charges include the return cost of transport to Edinburgh, a packed lunch, the fee owing to RCPE and RCSE for those fully registered, and the cost of transport and the packed lunch for the self-guided tours of Edinburgh that Accompanying Persons may wish to undertake.

## **Accommodation**

Three kinds of accommodation are available at St Andrews: single (4'6'' wide bed), double bedded (4'6'' wide bed), and twin bedded rooms (one 4'6'' wide bed plus one 4' wide bed). All rooms have en suite facilities (for pictures and other details see the main web page). When completing the Registration Form you will need to specify which kind you would like. Wheel chair access is available.

Note that we cannot guarantee being able to accept Registration/Accommodation bookings after **June 1st, 2005**. At that date, we shall have entered into specific commitments with St Andrews and cannot guarantee to refund any payments in the event of Registrants cancelling after June 1<sup>st</sup>.
